Confession and Forgiveness


- P: Blessed be the holy Trinity, one God, who greets us in this and every season, whose word never fails, whose promise is sure.

The Apostles' Creed


I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.



The Offertory Prayer






Holy Communion


